

CURRICULUM VITAE



Chua Choon Hwa is the Deputy Undersecretary for Policy Division, Ministry of Women, Family and Community Development. He graduated from University Malaya in 1996 with a B.A (Hons) in Public Policy. He joined the Malaysian civil service in 1996 as an Administrative and Diplomatic Officer and was posted to the Ministry of Defence as an Assistant Secretary in the Finance Division. During his five years tenure in the Ministry, he was involved in finance management and participated in international events like the Langkawi International Maritime and Aerospace Exhibition.

In 2001, he furthered his studies in the National Graduate Institute for Policy Studies, Japan and was awarded Masters in Policy Science. Upon his return in 2002, he was posted as the Senior Assistant Secretary in the Finance Division in Ministry of Finance. His portfolio in the Ministry of Finance involves managing Venture Capitals, Employees' Provident Fund and Government Link Companies. As a senior officer in the Ministry, he was involved in the annual Malaysian Budget preparation. He had also participated in various international meetings and dialogues. Among them are the 38th Annual Meeting of the Islamic Development Bank in 2005 and loan negotiations with Japan Bank for International Corporation in 2006.

In 2009, Chua was posted as the Principal Senior Assistant Secretary in the Policy Division, Ministry of Women, Family and Community Development. His job scope involves formulating policy for the Ministry's target group specifically children. Being in this position, he has delivered presentation and speeches in various national and international forums which included the 22nd Session of the Human Rights Council in Geneva, Switzerland and the 46th Session of the United Nations Commission on Population and Development (CPD) in New York, United States.

In 2013, he is promoted as the Deputy Undersecretary in the same division and his portfolio now has expanded to involve other target groups in the Ministry, namely the elderly, disabled, homeless and vulnerable groups. In carrying out his tasks, he is actively involved with the various NGOs for the related target groups.
